was finally founded in **early February 2006**

Earlier activities leading up to that include, chronologically:

- June 1979 was the **100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of St. Boniface Church** with a huge outdoor Mass and celebration. *Let us Remember*, a local pictorial history was published by Dr. Raymond Heuberger for the church.
- Rev. Arthur Dernbach, Pastor 1997-2001, collected and stored more pieces of parish history.
- In 2002 Henry Strobel registered **saintboniface.net**, published in 2003 on his *History of Sublimity* web pages with Pastor Patrick Donoghue's blessing.
- June 2004 was the **125<sup>th</sup> anniversary of St. Boniface Church** - and the 1250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the martyrdom of its patron saint Boniface. A German sausage picnic and music welcomed the community. Evangeline Ripp and Vera Boedigheimer presented an extensive historical display in the old convent.
- June 2005 Henry Strobel was appointed to the Portland Archdiocesan Historical Commission.
