The following pages are only those pertaining to the Archdiocese of Oregon City, Oregon. Here are a few notes added by Henry Strobel, 2012

First, yes, the Sandwich Islands are the Hawaiian Islands.

1888 was one year before the present St. Boniface church in Sublimity was built, two years after the religious order later known as Sisters of St. Mary of Oregon was founded (which seems to be missed here). Otherwise it seems very thorough.

It's informative to glance through these few pages and see how thinly spread the priests were in those days. Most of the places listed were "attended from" another parish. For example:

*Sublimity, Linn Co., St. Boniface', attended from Gervais every Sunday*  
(Well, it's in Marion County now . . .)

*Gervais, Marion Co., 88 [souls] Gervase and Protase's [patron saints], Rev. Anselm Wachter O.S.B., rector*

We recognize Fr. Wachter as one of the Benedictines who "attended" to Sublimity in the early days.

*Oregon City, Clackamas Co., Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist, (600) [souls], Rev. Wernher Ruettimann, O.S.B., rector*

The popular Swiss Benedictine, who died young and is buried at Mt. Angel Abbey, was apparently first placed at the cathedral church and then assigned as resident pastor at Sublimity.
